

The *Gosling*

From Wild Goose Kamados

1. To hatch your Gosling, cut the nylon bands securing the packaging and carefully remove from the box.



2. Open the lid and remove all of the contents, including the ceramic firebowl from within

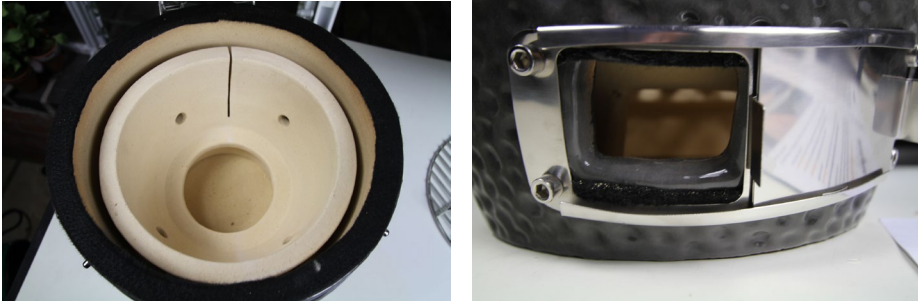


3. Take the stand, and whilst ensuring that the bolt head is secured in the surrounding recessed sides of the slot, screw the plastic knob behind it, to tighten. As it becomes tight, splay the stand legs into a 'Y' formation and completely tighten to secure. Remove the backing from the 3 pieces of heat resistant, felt fabric and apply them to the stand legs, with the thickest piece on the lower leg. The graded thickness of the 3 pieces brings the 3 lower legs to the same height as the top leg, allowing the Gosling to sit flat.



4. Gently place the Gosling on the stand, ensuring that the the 3 legs of the stand are to the rear, to provide some stability when the lid is raised.

5. Lift the lid and return the firebowl to the Gosling. You should orientate this so that the gap at the bottom of the firebowl lines up with the main bottom vent, thus allowing good airflow, and access for the removal of ashes.



6. Place the black, cast iron grate at the bottom of the bowl, before putting the stainless still grill on top.



7. Finally, lower the lid and place the cast iron vent on top, with the logo facing forward. Now simply attach the wooden handle and you are ready to go!
